Outline of
the Chart

1. From Eternity, at the Beginning, when the Father; Son and Holy Spirit; the Eternal Trinity with an Eternal Purpose, UNTIL Eternity at the End, when he New Heavens and the New Earth will be permanently established, represents 'TIME—' Man's Probationary Period.

2. This Period of TIME is divided into-

(a) FOUR GREAT DIVISIONS:

- i. The Beginning or Peopling of the Earth—From Creation to the Tower of Babel when mankind was scattered throughout the earth.
- ii. The Time of the Hebrews—From the call of Abrahan to the time of Nebuchadnezzar, when the Hebrews were carried into captivity. Note the Prophetic Break from Nebuchadnezzar to the Return of the Messiah when All Israel will again come into the limelight.

iii. The Time of the Gentiles—To continue, according to the great Image Dream of Nebuchadnezzar, through Five World Empires. Four of these (Babylon, Mcdo-Persia, Greece, Rome) have already become History, and since we have no World Empire to-day, we know that the Fifth, a Ten-King Confederacy, headed up under the Anti-Christ, is yet to come. Note, therefore that we are not now in the Times of Gentiles. Here is another Prophetic Break. They will begin again after the Appearing of Christ and will last Seven years.

iv. The DAY of GRACE, the CHURCH AGE—From the Day of Pentecost to the Appearing of Christ, when God is calling out of the World, a people for His Name (Acts 15:13-14).

3. The Chart is also divided longitudinally into three cross-sections—
(a) The Place of Death (SHEOL).

This you will note, consists of upper and Lower Compartments separated by a Great Gulf impassible.

- (b) THE STATE OF LIVING—Covering the space from the Grave-yard representation to the Horizon Line above. It is along this section that the Divisions of Time are represented.
- (c) THE HEAVENLIES—This Cross-section is wholly situated above the Horizon Line, and covers the Third Heaven above where God is. You will note the position of Satan in Heavenlies.

The purpose of the Chart is to show that the Bible is one Harmonious Whole. Every Passage of Scripture from the First Verse of the First Chapter of Genesis to the last verse of the chapter of Revelation accurately and exactly fits into its place without being trimmed or altered or mutilated in any way.
